Week 1  Due: 5/6/17	Copy your secondary school's crest and motto. What do they tell you about your school?	Copy your secondary school's crest and motto. Week 5  Due: 3/7/17	Write a list of clubs available at your secondary school.	Create a timetable showing the day and time of each club available at your secondary school.	Choose one club you would like to attend and explain why.	Put the clubs available at your secondary school in order of preference and give a reason for each choice.
Week 6  Due: 10/7/17	What are you looking forward to about going to secondary school? Write a list in your homework book.	What are you looking forward to about going to secondary school? Add a column to show where you could go for help about anything you are nervous about.	Find someone who is already at your secondary school. It might be a brother or sister or a friend. Interview them to find out more about what to expect. Record your interview in your homework book.

If you are working in a group, you should meet with them and decide who will do what for homework. If you need time to practise your presentations, you can come to homework club.
