

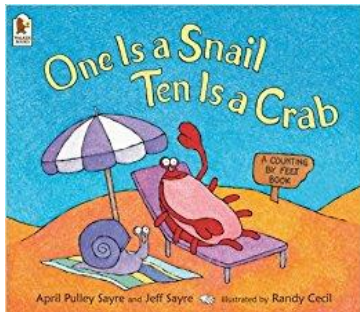
Messages:

Topic:

In topic this week, the children will be learning about the origins of Bonfire Night and making arts and crafts linked to this in the art room.
