

Messages:

We welcomed a set of hatching eggs yesterday into Reception. They will be in our classroom for the next two weeks. Over the course of the two weeks we will be keeping a daily diary of the things we observe and looking after the chicks when they hatch. We are all very excited about it!

Just a quick reminder that children should not bring toys or personal possessions to school. We have lots of toys for the children to play with in the classroom and there is always the risk that they will get damaged or even lost.

Topic:

As well as observing our hatching eggs and keeping a diary about what happens on each day they are with us we will be learning about the origins of Mother's Day and the different ways people celebrate it around the world.

English:

In English this week, we will be reading the story of The Little Red Hen. We will look at the setting and the characters in the story and sequence events. The children will have the opportunity to re-enact the story using finger puppets and props.

We will also be matching lowercase letters to their capital letters.

Maths:

In maths this week, we will continue to look at addition and subtraction. We will be adding and taking away with numbers up to 10 and then 20.
