



Year 1 Weekly update: 2nd July 2018

Messages:

Next week, on **Monday 9th July**, Year 1 will be going on a trip to the National Portrait Gallery as part of the nationwide 'Take One Picture' project. We will provide packed lunches but the children are welcome to bring their own. Please make sure your child has a bottle of water because it is likely to be a hot day. Thank you for your support.

Maths:

This week, the children will begin revising what they have learned over the course of the year. We will focus on addition and subtraction, revisiting the use of mental methods, partitioning and number lines. The children will be encouraged to work with two digit numbers over 30. They will also practice mental addition by holding a number in their head and counting on.

English:

The children will be learning about the artist William Turner in English lessons this week. We will look at some of his stormy seascapes together and the children will imagine how it would have felt to have been a sailor in those times. They will focus on using adventurous vocabulary and using phonetic strategies to spell longer words.

Topic and science:

In topic this week, the children will discuss the difference between mammals and fish. Using what they have learned, they will sort and classify different sea creatures into two categories.

There will be no science this week due to our school trip on Monday.
