



Year 1 Weekly update: 25th June 2018

Messages:

Year 1 have two trips on the horizon. Please read the letter your child will bring home this week for more information.

On **Monday 2nd July**, Year 1 will be going on a trip to Coram's Fields to celebrate all they have learned in country dancing lessons this year.

Maths:

This week, the children will be continuing to learn about money. They will put coins in order of value, make different amounts using coins and add two or three coins together. Their work on partitioning will help the children to add coins using mental methods.

English:

The children will be learning about riddles this week. They will be given riddles to solve and introduced to the main features of riddles. They will then create their own sea creature riddles at the end of the week.

Topic and science:

There will be no topic lessons this week due to Sports Day.

In science, the children will examine how much their plants have grown and draw a labelled diagram.
