

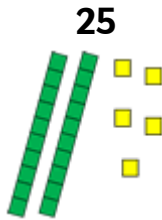
## Year 1 Weekly update: 27<sup>th</sup> February 2018

This week, we will revisit place value. The children will practise counting forwards and backwards to 100. They will also use dienes to learn about tens and units.

### Topic and science:
