

Messages:

Thank you to all the parents that helped on our school trip to London Zoo last week. The children had a fantastic time! Our next Year 2 trip is to the National Gallery in July and we would love to have helpers join us if you did not get a chance to join us this time.

This week the children will be preparing for the **Science Fair** that is taking place in the afternoon on **Tuesday 19th June**. Parents will be invited to come and see the children's fantastic science experiments on this day.

Maths:

This week we will be learning to estimate sensible answers to questions using our existing knowledge of number. We will also be returning to money, and practising using coins to make different amounts in a variety of ways. We will also be revising time and talking about the significant times of the day e.g. school starting, lunchtime, home time and bedtime etc.

Phonics / Spellings:

This week your child will be learning homophones and near homophones.

Your child needs to copy out each spelling using look, cover, write, check. You may find it useful to have a practice spelling test!

Your child needs to write 3 sentences using as many of the words as they can.

English:

This week the children will be writing up their science experiment. This will be a non-fiction piece, written as instructions. The children will be learning about the common features of instructions such as numbers, time openers and imperative verbs.

Topic:

This week we will be comparing life in Brazil to life in London. The children will be discussing differences and similarities by looking at photos and watching videos.

Science:

This week the children will be conducting an experiment to investigate what plants need to grow.

Homework:

Please learn your spellings and complete the maths homework.
