

### Messages:

- This week, children will be introduced to the Shakespeare play that they will have the opportunity to take part in when they reach Year 5.

### Maths:

This week, children will explore the properties of shape and will learn how to translate a shape on a grid.

We will then review areas from the maths paper that the children found tricky, particularly adding three numbers and the bus stop method.

### English:

Children are retelling the Greek Myth – Icarus, the Boy who Flew Too High. We will write one section each day and publish our finished story on Friday.

### Science:

There will be no science lesson this week. Instead, children will have two topic lessons.

### Topic:

Year 4 are continuing their work on The Romans. We will be learning about Boudicca and Roman Baths. Children in WS class will also have the chance to paint their clay vases.

### Homework:

Reminders: topic and science are optional; spellings, times tables and Mathletics are compulsory every week.
