

Year 6 Weekly Update: 23rd April 2018

Messages: We have introduced a new spelling system – instructions are stuck into children’s homework books. Please look at the spelling your child has chosen on a weekly basis. You can contact the Year 6 team if you have any further questions. The attendance party will take place on Monday 23rd April 2018, children can bring their own clothes and are able to change at lunchtime. Nearly all children are now completing their homework – thank you for the continued support.

Maths:

Katija: This week, we will be working on coordinates. Children will describe the positions on the full coordinate grid (all 4 quadrants). We will also complete SATs style questions including missing coordinates.

Eugene: Children will be learning about area and perimeter this week. We will be looking at different shapes and calculating the area and also finding the perimeter and considering if these are the same. We will also use a formula to find the area of shapes. Children will also complete word problems linked to area and perimeter.

Spellings:

This half term, we would like children to choose the spellings they want to practise themselves so that their homework is addressing their specific needs. They will choose them from the Year 5 and 6 spelling list or the Year 6 spelling patterns. They will then be tested on these words by a partner on a Monday afternoon. This is instead of learning a perfect paragraph. We hope this means they will be able to challenge themselves!

English:

As we completed the reading revision last week, this week children will have an opportunity to practise a reading paper and implement newly learned skills. We will discuss and share answers including ‘How can you tell...?’ and ‘What impression...?’.


SPaG: We will be completing SPaG revision.

Self-directed revision:

Children will have the opportunity to reflect on their learning and consider areas they would like to revise. This week we will be holding a self-directed revision afternoon giving children time to choose their revision topic.

Science: Science will be replaced with revision lessons in preparation for SATs.

Homework: Children now need to complete compulsory homework from the reading comprehension book and the maths workbook. In addition, the spelling, perfect paragraph and weekly grammar and punctuation worksheet will be in homework books. Topic and science homework will also be provided but these are optional. Homework is due on **Monday**. New homework is sent home by **Tuesday**.
