Maths:

This week, we will focus on arithmetic and reasoning skills. We will look at mathematical problems and look to solve these in a logical way. Children will be encouraged to use mathematical vocabulary to explain the methods they have used.

English:

Children will continue to work on Street Child. This week, we will look at a model and consider the audience as well as make a plan. Children will carry out research on Workhouses and use this to plan and then draft reports. There will also be time to proof read our work for spelling and punctuation errors.

Spellings:
