Furthermore, we will complete word problems and discuss the important information given and what operation we need to use to solve the word problem.

English:

This week, we will be exploring features of a quest story. Children will explore the hero and the problem they have to overcome. We will consider the setting and the atmosphere when planning the story as well as planning to integrate dialogue to move action forward.

Topic: Our focus this week will be crime and punishment. We will learn about different types of punishment in Tudor times, we will look at the plight of Henry VIII’s political and religious prisoners and the severe punishments that were extended to them.

Science:

In science this week, children will explore who Carl Linnaeus was and how he has had an impact on taxonomy. They will know how living things are classified using the Linnaean system.
